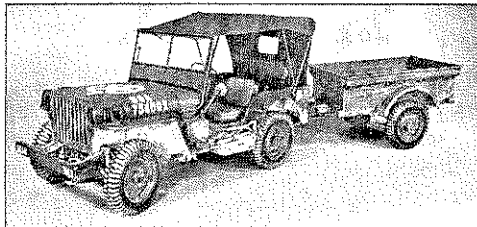

Look at what those horrible Military Vehicle flea marketeers sold at Aberdeen

Boy buys live ammo at Army flea market

ABERDEEN, Md. — A teenager bought a live military training shell at a flea market at Aberdeen Proving Ground, and Army officials are warning that other live shells may have been sold.

The 40mm shell, called an M-781, contains an orange dye in its nose, not an explosive, said Aberdeen spokesman George Mercer.

But it contains a .38-caliber blank with about as much gunpowder as a powerful firecracker, Mercer said Tuesday.

"It could seriously injure your hand or eyes" if dropped, hit, or heated, he said.

Officials did not know who sold the shell or whether more were sold. About 150 vendors were at the Armed Forces Day flea market Saturday, Mercer said.

A teenager bought the shell for \$5, but his mother turned it over to Aberdeen officials.
