The Corn Picker is just what is needed to cope with Fall clean-up of the North 40. This, we are told, attaches easily to the Jeep and with the optional heater and shown half cab lets you in comfort clean up those stalks before the deer can really eat all of the corn. THE 'Jeep' CORN PICKER

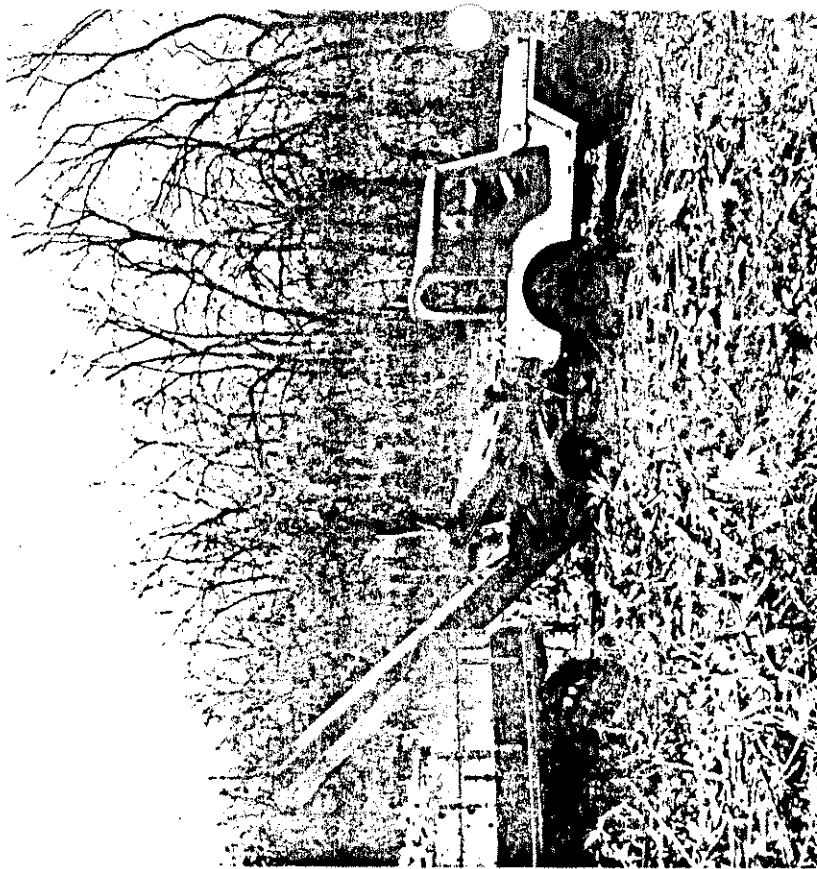


VISIBILITY

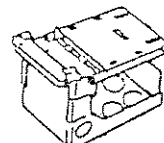

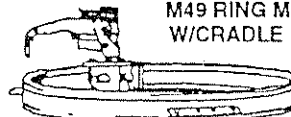

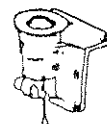

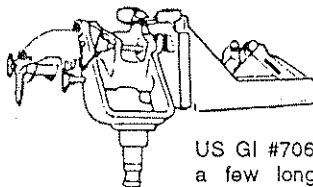
