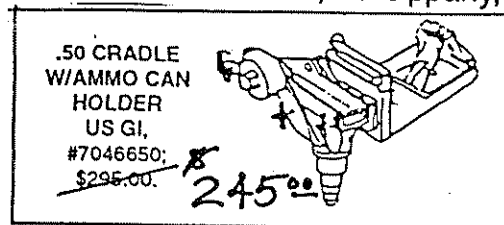
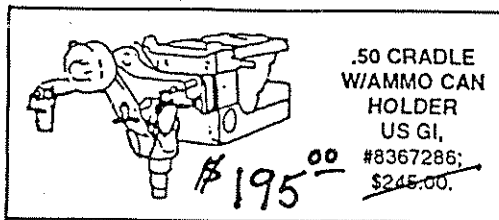

Jeep accessories, part 9. Now that most of the leaves are on the ground you can use your Universal Jeep for the big cleanup. What you need is the rotary broom as a sweepster. This uses the front power takeoff. It was available in any width up to 10 feet. It could be mounted with the Meyer snow plow, but this combination had to be noted when ordering. In 1960 it cost \$1095. Steel bristles were an extra \$200, and a built in sprinkler system for dust abatement was \$165.

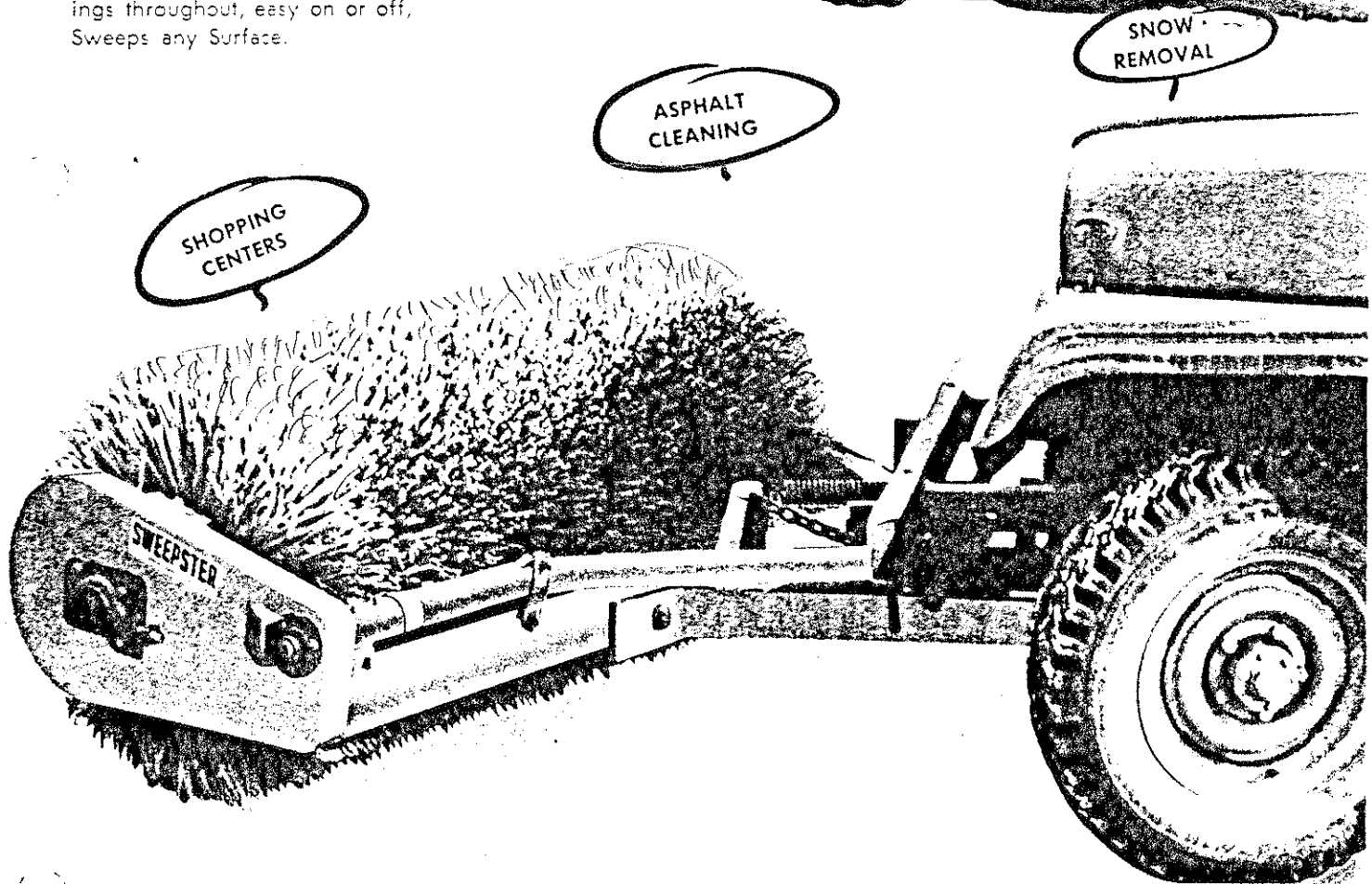

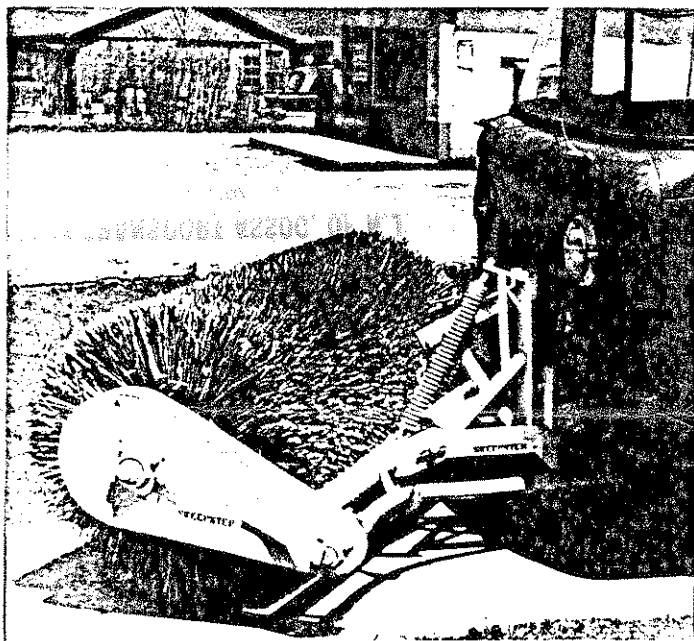
