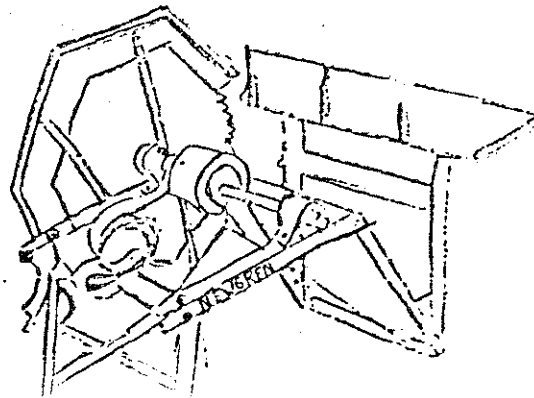
The first fall winds bring buzz saw business. There are a few buzz saws available for the Jeep.

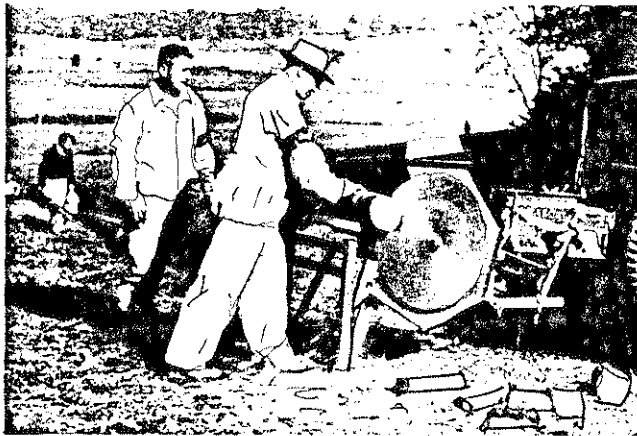
### STOCKLAND HYDRO-SCOOP DESIGNED FOR UNIVERSAL 'JEEP'

Only Hydro-Scoop digs, lifts, carries, dumps and spreads in either forward or reverse position. Ideal for excavating, landscaping, terracing, ditching, leveling, dam and road building. 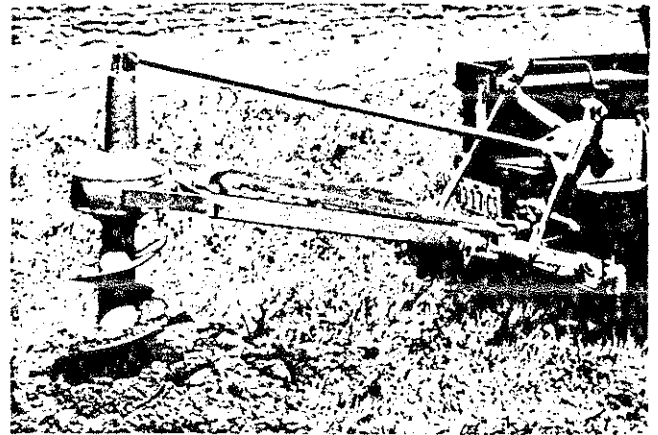
### ROPER POST HOLE DIGGERS
